## VET

VET stands for Vocational Education and Training. VET is education and training that gives students skills for work, particularly in the trades and industry. In other words, VET is education and training that gives students skills and knowledge for work. It is the kind of education offered by TAFE colleges and a range of other registered training organisations. Students have the opportunity to undertake VET as part of the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).

## CALCULATORS

It is a requirement that all mathematics students have their own calculators. The use of a calculator on Mobile phones is not allowed as they do not have the required functionality.

Their current new price is \$29.95 (gst inclusive), including a padded case and extended five year warranty. There is no profit for the school. Calculators will be delivered to the school for the start of the school year.
